For security reasons, your username, password, and secret question have been reset. Please follow the instructions below to sign in to your MyMedicare.gov account.

To sign in to MyMedicare.gov:

1. Go to MyMedicare.gov.
2. In the **Username** field, enter your Medicare number without dashes.
3. In the **Password** field, enter this temporary password: **<password>**
4. After you sign in, you'll be asked to create a username that is different from your Medicare number and a new password, which you will use every time you sign in to your MyMedicare.gov account.
5. If you forget your username or password, click the **Trouble Signing In?** link on the MyMedicare.gov welcome page. You'll be guided through the process to recover your username and reset your password.

Now that you're registered on MyMedicare.gov, which is a secure and personalized website, you can manage your personal information by using features that let you:

- Create and maintain a list of your favorite health care providers
- View claim statuses and your yearly deductible status
- Sign up to receive your Medicare Summary Notices (MSNs) electronically
- Access online forms, publications, and messages sent to you by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)
- View your preventive services and recording your medical history
